

YMI's Our Daily Bread Reader for Mobile Phones (Java Application)

The Our Daily Bread (ODB) Reader for Mobile Phones is a simple Java application (a MIDlet) meant for users who prefer to use the devotional on their mobile phones. The application runs only on Java-enabled mobile phones.

The ODB Reader will be useful to users of the devotional who may not have the printed edition or a device that has available internet connection.

How to Install The ODB Reader

(for example, for the month of March 2010)

Direct download:

1. Download the ODB Reader from YMIblogging through the phone's internet browser.
2. Run the JAR file to install.

Download to your computer:

1. Download the ODB Reader from YMIblogging.
2. Transfer to your phone using the phone's software or by accessing it through file explorer.
3. On the phone, run the JAR file to install.

Direct download:

1. Download the ODB Reader install files (File 1 and File 2) from YMIblogging through the phone's internet browser.
2. Run the JAR file only (File 1) to install.

Download to your computer:

1. Download the ODB Reader install files from YMIblogging.
2. Transfer the two files to your phone using the phone's sync software or by accessing it through file explorer.
3. On the phone, run the JAR file only (File 1) to install.
